

## **Loomis PIE Basketball Tournament**

Saturday, January 23, 2021 Boys & Girls 5<sup>th</sup>/6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup>



The Loomis youth basketball tournament will take place on Saturday, January 23, 2021 in Loomis, Ne starting at 8:30AM. The Tournament is open to Boys & Girls in  $5^{\text{th}}/6^{\text{th}}$  grade &  $7^{\text{th}}/8^{\text{th}}$  grade. All games will be held at Loomis High School, in two full-size gymnasiums.

**Entry Fee**: Registration fee for all teams is  $\underline{\$125}$ . Please complete the provided team registration form below and mail back with payment. Each team must pay with one check payable to "Loomis Public Schools".

**Tournament Format**: this is a single day tournament, with a max of 8 teams in boys and girls divisions. All teams are guaranteed 3 games. Consolation games will be played for 3rd, 5th and 7th places. Medals will be presented to  $1^{st}$ ,  $2^{nd}$ , and  $3^{rd}$  place finishers.

**Eligibility**: Younger players may be brought up from lower grades. Players can compete on only one team in the tournament. If incorrect information is provided, the player and team may be ineligible.

**Rules**: Games will consist of 8-minute quarters. The clock will stop on all free throws, timeouts, player injuries, and the last minute of each quarter. All teams must have matching numbered jerseys.  $7^{th}/8^{th}$  grades teams may press up to 15-point lead, and  $5^{th}/6$ th grade teams may only press in the last minute of the  $4^{th}$  quarter up to a 10-point lead.

### General Rules:

- Each team must provide its own bookkeeper and warm-up balls.
- Younger players from lower grades will be allowed to play up if needed.
- A Baden BX6E intermediate sized ball (28.5) will be used for all games.
- Top team in the bracket is designated the home team and will be the <u>official</u> scorebook and must sit at scorer's table.
- There will be NO dressing rooms or showers available.
- All teams must have matching, numbered jerseys. Either two jerseys (white & darkcolored jerseys) or reversible jerseys are required with the designated home team wearing white.
- Any player or coach who is ejected for unsportsmanlike conduct will be required to leave the premises and will not be eligible to compete in any remaining games.

## Game Rules:

- 8 minute quarters will be played with the clock stopping ONLY for:
  - 1. All free throws
  - 2. Official & team timeouts
  - 3. Last minute of each half
  - 4. After 25 point lead clock will run continuous
- Each team is allowed (2) 1-minute timeouts per game with an additional full timeout for overtime.
- If game is tied at the end of regulation, a 1-minute overtime period will be played with the clock stopping on all dead balls. The second overtime will be sudden death with NO timeouts.
- $7^{\text{th}}/8^{\text{th}}$  grade team may press anytime during the game up to a 15-point lead.
- 5<sup>th</sup>/6<sup>th</sup> grade teams can only full court press in <u>the last minute of the fourth quarter</u> up to 10-point lead, then must pick up their defense at half court. After 15 point lead defense must pick up inside the three-point line regardless of the quarter.
- The clock will run continuous whenever a team is up by more than 25 points.
- On a shooting foul, the player will be given the option to shoot from the regulation free throw line (15 ft.) or from a moved up free throw line (12 ft.)
- Substitutions must check in and wait at scorer's table for next dead ball.
- 5 fouls allowed per player.
- Teams will enter the bonus on the seventh foul and double bonus on the tenth foul. Bonus and double bonus will carry over into overtime.
- Each game will start with at least a 5-minute warm-up for the team's first game and a 3-minute warm-up for the following games depending on time and a 3-minute halftime.
- Substitutions will wait at scorer's table for next dead ball to enter but clock will not stop unless for one of the reasons stated above.
